Please note there will be one course for all levels of fast to allow one walk through Jump Height Order – Small to Tall all weekend.

Please consult the AKC Regulations for Agility Trials for a complete description and eligibility for entry into these classes. The exhibitor is fully responsible for entering the dog in the correct class(es)/height divisions. Dogs running in a lower height division than they are eligible for will be eliminated.

JUMP HEIGHT CARDS

Jump height cards are no longer required to be submitted with the entry form. The entry form has been changed to indicate whether the dog has been issued a temporary or permanent height card, or needs to be measured. If the dog needs to be measured it is the handler's responsibility to ensure that the box on the entry form is checked, and that the dog is measured prior to running, either by the judge of record or by a VMO or AKC rep if present

WAITING LIST

A waiting list of up to 100 runs per day will be maintained. Per Chapter 1, Section 16.1 of the Regulations for Agility Trials, a "waiting list close date" will be instituted. **The "waiting list close" will be March 2, 2018 at 6:00 pm.** Full refunds will be given to those exhibitors withdrawing **ONLY** for the runs that are able to be filled from the waiting list.

DOG ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs fifteen (15) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP), **an AKC Canine Partners listing number**, or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to compete. Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations it includes both sexes.

Dogs should be physically sound. Dogs that are blind shall not be eligible, and neither are bitches in season, aggressive dogs, or dogs suffering from any deformity, injury, or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance. No dog shall compete if it is taped or bandaged in any way or has anything attached to it for medical purposes. Refer to Chapter 2 of the Registration and Discipline Rules for the listing of registerable breeds that may participate. Puppies under six months of age are strictly prohibited from the trial grounds.

Swamp Dog will check with the AKC for "Dogs Ineligible to Compete in AKC Events" and entries will be declined according to that list as directed by the American Kennel Club.

OBSTACLES AND RING CONDITIONS

Obstacles will meet the specifications for obstacles in the current edition of the Regulations for Agility Trials. All classes will take place outdoor under cover on packed dirt. One ring measuring 73' x 120'.

Inquiries may be directed to Rosalind Guillet at rozguillet@gmail.com. No entry shall be made and no entry shall be accepted which specifies any conditions as to its acceptance.

Illegible entries will not be processed and will be returned to the exhibitor. Returned checks do not constitute a valid entry and the Trial Secretary will add a **\$30.00** collection fee to the amount of each returned check.

COURSE WALK-THROUGHS AND WARM-UP INFORMATION

Handlers in all classes are permitted to walk the course, without a dog, during a walk-through period held prior to the start of the class. The walk-through is restricted to handlers entered in that class only. Handlers with multiple dogs, at events with multiple rings may request to walk with a height group other than the one their dog is entered in if a conflict is imminent.

A warm-up area, consisting of a regulation agility jump, will be provided for exhibitors. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the dog and not for training or relieving of the dog.

RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES

Ribbons will be awarded in each jump height division in each class as follows:

- First Place*.....*Blue*
- Second Place*.....*Red*
- Third Place*.....*Yellow*
- Fourth Place*.....*White*
- Qualifying*
- Score*.....*Dark Green*

A New Title rosette will be awarded to all dog and handler teams finishing a title. A MACH, PACH or PAX rosette and MACH/PACH/PAX bar will be awarded to all dog and handler teams that attain their MACH, PACH or PAX. A dog toy or dog related item will be given to each dog entered (one toy per dog for the weekend). Double Q and Triple Q Ribbons will also be available for teams with qualifying scores.

NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR and LIABILITY

The **safety of the dog** is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all obstacles safely.

It is **expressly understood** that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the show site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. Swamp Dog Agility Club and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property and further assumes no responsibility for injury to children.

Swamp Dog Agility Club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against **Swamp Dog Agility Club** or any official thereof.

All dogs must be on leash at all times when on trial grounds except when in the designated warm-up area or competing on the course.

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee.

Bitches in season are not permitted to compete in Agility Trials. As such, the club will refund **entry fees less \$5 per day** of the entry fee paid for bitches unable to compete for this reason upon presentation of a veterinarian certificate. This certificate must be presented to the Trial Secretary prior to the start of judging on the first day of the trial.

RINGSIDE

Dogs may arrive any time prior to judging if they have a valid height card. Otherwise, they must be available for measuring prior to the start of their class. **Judges are not required** to wait for dogs. The Owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at ringside when it is to be judged. The Club has no responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

CATALOGS

A limited number of catalogs will be available for sale at the trial site for a cost of **\$10**. Running order Will be sent prior to the trial and/or available on the clubs website www.swampdogagility.com.

VENDORS

Vendors must be pre-approved. A vendor fee of \$25 per day will be charged. If you would like a vendor space, please contact Rosalind at (985) 201-4978 or rozquillet@gmail.com.

MOVE UPS

Dogs may be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of qualifying for an agility title, provided that request is made to the Trial Secretary in writing no later than the Monday before the trial. Move-ups over the weekend will be accommodated, provided the information is provided within 30 minutes after the last class of the day concludes.

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

Crating space will be available. No ex-pens allowed Crates may be left overnight; however, Swamp Dog Agility Club and the Playmakers Soccer will not be responsible for any lost or damaged items left at the show site.

Food concession will not be available, but there are several local restaurants and fast food chains very close by. Lunches will be provided to workers.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Trial Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available at various locations around the show grounds.

RV Facilities:

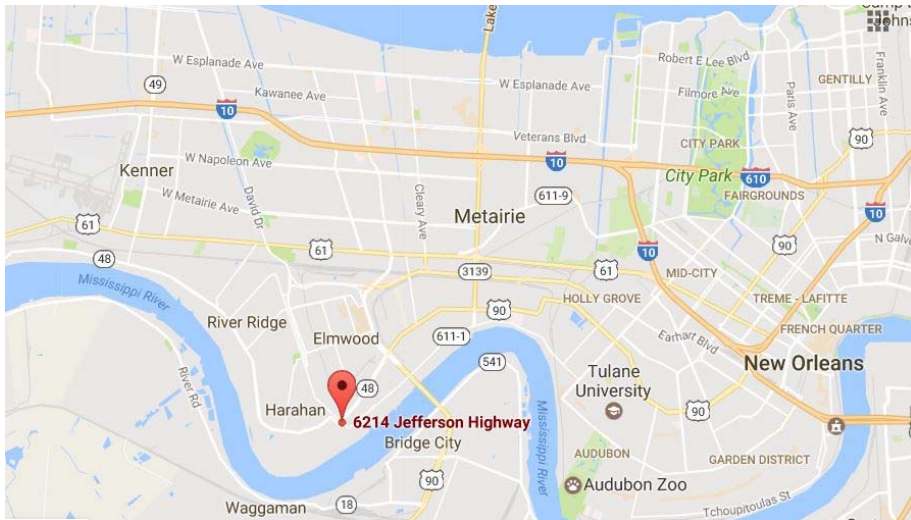
There are no available RV spaces at this facility. With limited parking spaces located at the arena, no parking of RVs will be allowed in that lot at any time. There is overflow parking at the adjacent businesses and a large gravel lot where RVs can be parked during the day. RV parking is available nearby at the New Orleans West KOA located as 11129 Jefferson Highway, River Ridge, LA 70123, (504) 467-1792. This campground is located 4.2 miles from the facility. Dry camping is also available on the local WalMart which is 1.3 miles away located at 5110 Jefferson Hwy, Harahan, LA 70123.



Directions to the Trial Site

From East on I-10 take Exit 223A-223B toward LA-49 New Orleans International Airport and merge onto Williams Boulevard/La-49. In .2 miles turn left onto Veterans Memorial Boulevard. Then in 1.2 miles turn right onto David Drive which becomes Dickory Avenue. In 1.6 miles turn right on Gardner Street and then left onto Hickory Avenue. Travel on Hickory Avenue 1.6 miles and turn left onto Jefferson Highway. Once you are on Jefferson Highway the Playmakers Soccer arena will be on your right.

From the West from I-10, take Exit 228 toward Causeway Boulevard South. Travel approximately 2.6 miles where Causeway ends at River Road and take a right onto River Road. Travel River Road approximately 2.5 miles to Hickory Avenue and turn right. At the next intersection take a right on Jefferson Highway and the Playmakers Soccer arena entrance will be to your right.

It is the option of the club to allow day-to-day move-ups. Exhibitors should refer to a club's premium list to verify the club's policy for moving a dog up. If offered, dogs shall be moved up to a higher class at the request of the owner, as a result of the dog qualifying for an agility title.

The request for moving up must be made to the Trial Secretary according to the club's published policy. All move-up entries are subject to availability of the class and payment of any difference in entry fee. Dogs so moved-up will be entered at the end of the running order. INSTRUCTIONS

Handlers whose dogs measure into the 8" through 20" regular jump height divisions may opt to enter in a higher or 24-choice height division for all Regular titling classes, but not in a division lower than their proper height division. Dogs who measure into the 24" regular jump height division may not enter 24-choice. Dogs entered in the Preferred classes must compete at the required jump height and may not compete in a jump height division higher or lower than their proper height division.

All dogs that have not been officially measured for an Agility Jump Height Card may still compete; however, they must be measured by a Judge of record, an Agility Field Representative, or a Volunteer Measuring Official, prior to running. If measured by the Judge of record, that measurement will be valid for this trial *or back-to-back trials* only. If a measurement is necessary, it is the exhibitor's responsibility to have their dog(s) measured prior to running. Dogs listed in the AKC Canine PartnersSM program may be eligible to enter all-breed AKC agility trials at the club's option. These dogs should be listed as All American Dog and must include their AKC number on the entry form and check the AKC No. box.

Junior Handlers should enter their Junior Handler number on the front of this form. Should you not have your Junior Handler number, it may be obtained from the American Kennel Club (919) 233-9767. If the Junior Handler is not the owner of the dog identified on the face of this form, what is the relationship of the Junior Handler to the Owner?
